Your assessment rate is calculated as a dollar figure per \$100 of your assessable earnings.

All employers pay a portion into the pool as they would with any insurance system; however, industries and employers that use the system more often will pay a higher rate than their counterparts. The main influences of assessment rates include:

- Your organization's current injury costs from new and ongoing claims
- Your industry's injury costs
- Your assessable workers' earnings
- The WCB's overall average assessment rate

The WCB has been able to maintain the average assessment rate paid in Manitoba at \$1.60 for 2009. It is expected that Manitoba will continue to have one of the lowest average rates across Canada.

The WCB is committed to reducing the number and effects of workplace injuries in Manitoba. Helping employers understand that their assessment rate is tied to their own injury record is just one of the ways the WCB hopes to encourage this change.
